

S1 E1- S1 E15 Summary

We will be looking at the stats from the rook season one episode one through episode fifteen. We will be looking at each episode individually for their stats in both race/nationality and gender. There will also be a quick synopsis of what crimes were committed.

For Episode One we learned about our justice group and who the main characters are. We also saw how the justice group would be interacting with one another. This episode was mostly about criminals who robbed places and were thieves, this wasn't all that was covered though as there was a domestic violence call-in and a bit of drug dealing.

Starting with race/nationality and gender we will be looking at three different groups: the justice group, the criminals, and the victims.

For the justice group, there were a total of thirteen people that we know the race/nationality and gender. There were seven White people of those White people two were female and five were male, four Blacks with three being male and one being female, one female Asian-American, and one female Mexican. Meaning we have 53.8% White, 30.8% Black, 7.7% Asian-American, and 7.7% Mexican. Along with eight males to five females, our male-to-female ratio was 61.5% male and 38.5% female.

As for the criminals we had a total of ten criminals. The breakdown is six White with an even split of three, so three White females and three White males. There were also three Mexicans all male. Along with one Asian male. Meaning we have 60% White 30% Mexican 10% Asian along with gender being 70% male and 30% female.

As for the victims we have three victims one of whom is a child. We saw a White female, a White boy, and a Mexican male. For our breakdown of race/nationality, we have 66.7% White 33.3% Mexican, and for gender, we have 66.7% male and 33.3% female.

Episode Two we got a quick recap of episode one and then quickly jumped into this episode starting with a car chase. Even with the opening scene this episode mostly covered drug addicts but we also had one person stealing a scissor lift from work and another person who was a kidnapper.

Now let's take a look at the stats for race/nationality and gender for our three groups: justice, criminal, and victim.

Starting with the justice group we have a total of eleven people. We saw five White people with four being White males and one being a White female. Next, we have four Black people and it's an even split of two Black females and two Black males. We still have the same Asian-American female and Mexican female as in the first episode. That means that 45.5% White 36.4% Black 9.1% Asian-American 9.1% Mexican. For gender, we have 54.5% male and 45.5% female. The male-to-female ratio is better and more realistic in this episode compared to the last one where the ratio was 61.5% male and 38.5% female.

We will now look at the criminals. We had a total of eight criminals in this episode. three are White, two are White males, and one is a White female. We had four male Mexicans. Along with one Black female. Which gives us percentages of 50% Mexican 37.5% White 12.5% Black and gender shows 75% male and 25% female.

Now looking at the victims. We had a total of four. Of the four victims we did have one being a teenage boy. Three of them were White, two White males and one White female. We also saw a Black female. That means we had a one-to-one ratio of 50% male and 50% female as for race we had 75% White and 25% Black.

Episode Three mostly consisted of thief and violent crimes. However, there was still one outlier who was a teen who ended up going into a cop car and went over the speaker.

Now let's take a look at the stats for race/nationality and gender for our three groups: justice, criminal, and victim.

Starting with the justice group we have seven people. We saw two Black males and one Black female, two White males, and one White female, along with one Asian-American female. So looking at percentages for race/nationality we have 42.9% White 42.9% Black 14.3% Asian-American. Now taking a look at gender we have 57.1% male and 42.9% female.

Looking at the criminals. We look at seven criminals. The percentages for race/nationality are 42.9% White 42.9% Black 14.3% Asian as for the gender numbers those are 57.1% male and 42.9% female.

Finally, we look at the victims. We have three people. All of whom are males, two being White and one being Mexican. So the percentages work out to be 66.7% White 33.3% Mexican for race/nationality and 100% male for gender. We have less diversity for the gender in this aspect than any of the others but the way they are a victim is different than the others. One of these men got stuck behind the ATM while trying to do maintenance, he was a victim of circumstance. One of the men was a boss who got his car vandalized by one of the employees he fired that day. And the final one you could argue is a criminal as much as he is a victim, he got into a fight with Officer Bradford but Bradford is the one who instigated the fight in the first place. Bradford did end up winning the fight and booking the biker for assaulting a police officer.

Episode Four consisted mostly of drug dealers and armed robbers but we also had one vehicle suspected of a hit and run and they also had expired tags.

Now let's take a look at the stats for race/nationality and gender for our three groups: justice, criminal, and victim.

Starting with the justice group we had a total of fifteen justice people. Seven are White, six being White male and one being a White female. We had four Black males and one Black female, a total of five Black justice people. Two Mexicans, one being female and one being male. We also had the same Asian-American female. This means we had 46.7% White, 33.3% Black, 13.3% Mexican, and 6.7% Asian-American. We also had a total of 73.3% males and 26.7% females.

As for criminals we had ten people. Two are White males, one Black male, and seven Mexican males. So we had 100% male criminals with 70% of them being Mexican, 20% being White, and 10% being Black. One of the Mexicans is a father who broke free to go to his daughter's quinceanera and was detained after the dance. As for two more of the Mexicans, they are gay and got engaged before being detained.

And finally, as for the victims we have only two. One was a White woman, she was simply in the wrong place at the wrong time and got shot in the leg during a shoot-out over drugs. The other is a White male who was a passenger in a car suspected of a hit and run along with having expired tags. He was almost wrongly arrested. This means we have 100% White with 50% female and 50% male, but as stated we had only two victims.

Finally, episode Five also consisted mostly of drug dealers but we had a few armed robberies and one drunk driver.

Now let's take a look at the stats for race/nationality and gender for our three groups: justice, criminal, and victim.

Starting with the justice group we have ten people. Four were White, with three being White males and one being a White female. Then we have four being Black, with three being Black males and one being a Black female. Along with our one Mexican female and one Asian-American female. Meaning we had 40% White, 40% Black, 10% Mexican, and 10% Asian-American for the race/nationality. As for gender, we had 60% males and 40% females.

Now looking at the criminals we have nine people. With five being White males, one being a Black male, along with three Russians with one being a Russian female and the other

two being Russian males. For race/nationality, we had 55.6% being White, 33.3% being Russian, and 11.1% being Black. As for gender, we have 88.9% were male and 11.1% were female.

Now looking at the victims we have three total but only two are shown on screen. One of them is a child, a Mexican male who is found face down in a pool. The other that was shown was a Mexican female, she had her throat slit. The last one who did not appear on screen but was talked about was a teen who got hit by a drunk driver, we were not told the teen's nationality/race but we were told that they were a male. Meaning we have 66.7% being Mexican and 33.3% being unknown for race/nationality. As for gender, 66.7% were male and 33.3% were female.

Episode Six consisted of an ex-cop who assaulted his soon-to-be ex-wife.

Looking at the criminals, all were male, 80% being white and 20% being black. There was burglary, domestic violence, brandishing a weapon, and much more.

Looking at all of the victims they are all white. 33.3% female and 66.7% male. There were a total of three victims, two of whom were related to the ex-cop. One being the soon-to-be ex-wife and the other being the son.

Looking at the justice group we have a lot of the same people again 14.3% are Mexican, 14.3% Asian-American, 28.6% white, and 42.9% black. 57.1% are male and 42.9% are female. This was our usual group of criminal justice officers.

Episode Seven had a VIP ride with a Hollywood director who did cause some issues where he was. The VIP was riding with Bishop and Nolan, where they were warned to keep him safe or it was their ass. The VIP decided to record one of the stops where there was a family dispute and the family pushed him to the ground. After the ride he offered money to the family to help with one of their facilities costs, this made him get attacked as they wanted the full safe of money. The three family/friends got separated and the one that got with the VIP got talked down, where the VIP then picked the gun up and got shot by a different cop.

The justice group got a few new faces including some lawyers. There were 18.2% Mexican, 9.1% Asian-American, 36.4% Black, and 36.4% White. With the majority 72.7% being male and 27.3% being Female.

Looking at the victims is nonexistent. There is one family mix of the family dispute, all of whom are black with all but one being male. The family was approximately five people. Along with one white woman at a party whose drink got spiked, luckily the officers noticed at the party the drink was spiked. The man got arrested and the woman did not drink her beverage.

As for our criminals, we have anything from public urination to being a weapons dealer. We had 10% Mexican, 30% Black, and 60% White. Along with 90% being male and 10% being female. We had a total of 10 criminals in this episode.

In Episode Eight we saw Nolan kill a suspect, and we were introduced to two new detectives, an ex-cop turned drug addict into an informant, and Bishop can take the detective test.

In the justice group, we have 10% Asian-American, 20% Mexican, 30% White, and 40% Black. The majority of them were males, 70%, and 30% females.

Looking at the criminals, all of them are white. 85.7% are male and 14.3% female. Two of the criminals were brothers and one got detained while the other got shot. Both were white males. The one who got shot was holding a gun and was shot by Officer John Nolan. The living brother accused Nolan of killing the brother in cold blood. He later attacked Nolan at his house.

Looking at the victims we have a total of five people. Four of them are a Chinese family, two parents, and two kids, an even split of male and female. The last one is a White woman who owns a convenience store that was being robbed.

Episode Nine piggybacked off of the previous episode. We learned that Nolan was cleared of the shooting and the attack of the living brother. The weapons dealer that was being hunted was finally tracked down and a baby was delivered during a shootout.

We had the largest number of criminals we have seen. 15 people were living in the same building working for the same boss, I was not able to get correct stats as they did not show them all. Those who were shown were Black or Mexican and all who were shown were males. In the justice group, we have 9.1% Asian-American, 9.1% Asian, 18.2% Mexican, 27.3% White, and 36.4% Black. The majority of them were males 72.7%, and 27.3% females.

There were no memorable victims to mention. All of the tenants who are low income could be argued to be the victims of the shootout in their building. However, not enough were shown for accurate statistics.

Episode Ten did not have any solid theme but the sergeant and captain went on patrol. So we will jump into the statistics.

Looking at the justice group we have 11.1% Mexican, 11.1% Asian-American, 33.3% Black, and 44.4% White. Along with 66.7% being male and 33.3% being female.

For criminals, we had a white man who hit the captain in the face. A Mexican man who was released from prison wanted to go back so he held a woman at gunpoint while in a police station with an officer's gun. There was a different Mexican man who stole the briefcase of a lawyer. And finally, a mother-son duo, who were white, and had multiple arrests.

Taking a look at victims there was a gas explosion that leaked into a house. The family was an Asian family of four. They had an even split of 2 males and 2 females.

Episode Eleven the cops were closing down roads and sidewalks which caused backup and traffic jams.

For the Justice group, we have 11.1% being Asian-American, 11.1% Mexican, 33.3% Black, and 44.4% White. There was a more even split this time 55.6% male and 44.4% female.

The criminals were six white men. Three of whom were robbing a weed shop. One was elder abuse as he tied his mom up trying to prevent her from hurting herself. One was a level two threat as he was writing threats. One was trying to scare another white guy after getting into a fight about a car accident and shooting a woman.

Finally looking at the victims we have two total. Both were white females. The first was elder abuse. The other was at the wrong time and wrong place, around early to mid-twenties, and shot in the chest. The younger woman was killed.

Episode Twelve had Nolan with a stalker and was over Valentines Day and a few days surrounding.

For the Justice group, we have 11.1% being Asian-American, 11.1% Mexican, 33.3% Black, and 44.4% White. There was a more even split this time 55.6% male and 44.4% female.

For criminals, we had two white males. One was suspected of being a serial killer but was diagnosed with dementia for about 30 years. While the other was indecent exposure.

Finally for victims, we have two women. One of whom we only hear about and was attacked by the serial killer. The other had a car crash and ended up getting electrocuted by a live wire.

Episode Thirteen was a drug bust where a quarter of a million dollars was stolen. It was a short episode so it did not have much going on. We had our usual justice group, not many shown criminals, and no victims.

For the Justice group, we have 11.1% being Asian-American, 22.2% Mexican, 33.3% Black, and 33.3% White. There were 66.7% male and 33.3% female. One of them was a dirty cop, a Mexican male.

There were six Mexican men as the criminals. Who were in the drug dealing gang.

Episode Fourteen was a plain clothes day. Meaning the TOs are wearing civilian clothes and are "not there". This caused one suspect to be able to flee, along with many other mistakes.

For the Justice group, we have 9.1% being Asian-American, 9.1% Mexican, 36.4% Black, and 45.5% White. There were 72.7% male and 27.3% female.

For victims, we have five people. All of whom are white, 4 females and 1 male. One male was getting beat up for stealing from two others. One woman was in a domestic violence situation and running away. Another had their hotel room broken into because of buying a car from a criminal, which she didn't know.

Looking at criminals we have five total, all of whom are males. We have 4 White males and 1 Black male. Two of the males, one of each, were beating up our male victim for stealing from them. The Black male was able to escape for a short period of time. One of the other White males was domestically abusing his wife.

Episode Fifteen was about a prison bus that crashed and seven hardcore felons escaped, which quickly turned into five felons. There was also a citizen militia trying to protect their neighborhood.

The justice group was very heavily White in this episode. 7.7% Asian-American, 7.7% Mexican, 38.5% Black, and 46.2% White. The same can be said for males. 30.8% female and 69.2% male.

For the victims, there were four people. One White male, two White females, and one Mexican male. The White male was the father of one of the White females, who is in kindergarten, and the child was held at gunpoint by one of the escaped felons. The other White female was the aunt of one of the felons and was also held at gunpoint. The one male Mexican was trimming bushes and got put under citizens' arrest wrongly by the militia.

The criminals excluding all of the people on the prison bus who did not commit additional crimes, meaning only two are being counted, are predominantly Black. 83.3% Black and 16.7% White, this number got inflated as there was a minimum of 15 black male gang members waiting to beat up one of the escaped prisoners. All 18 of the criminals were males.
